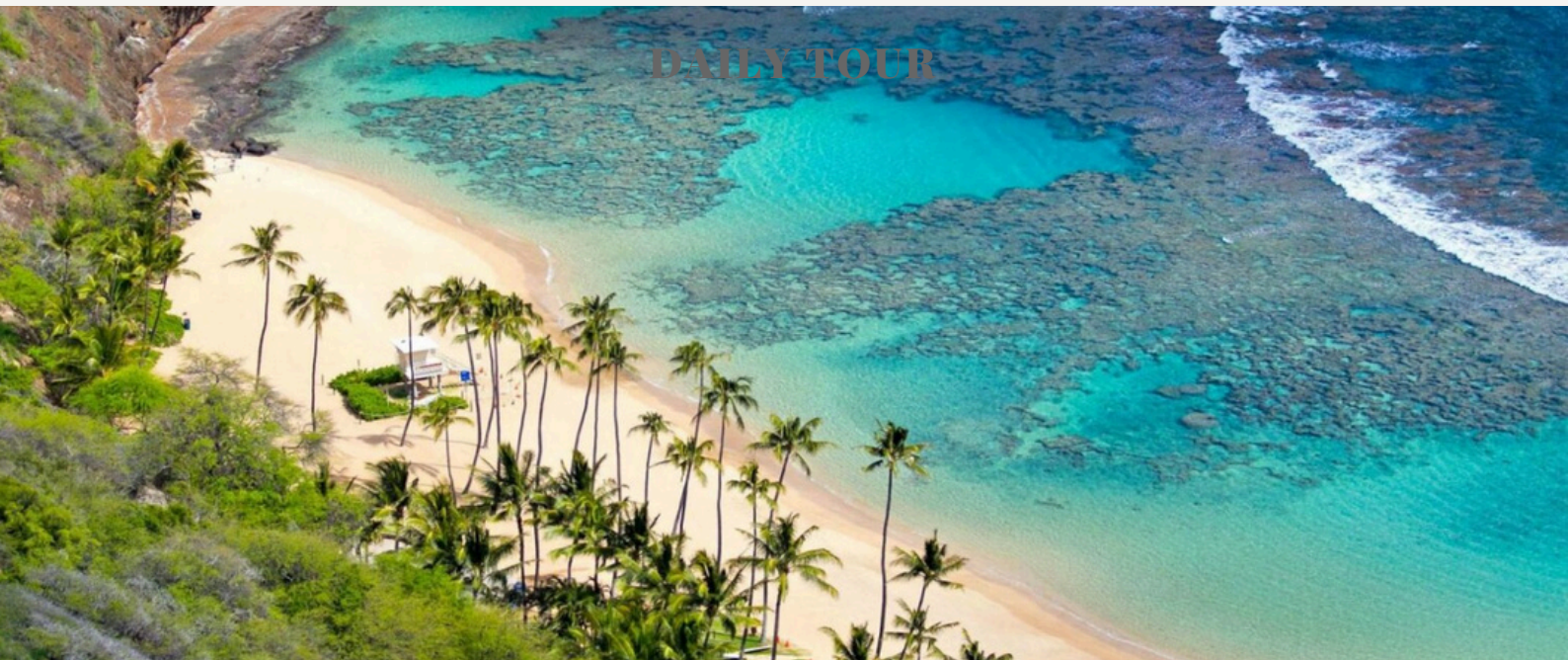


CHAM ISLAND SNORKELING TOUR

The Cham Islands (Cu Lao Cham) form a group of eight small islands recognized by UNESCO as a World Biosphere Reserve, with a population of around 3,000 people. Archaeologists believe that Cu Lao Cham was first settled by the Cham people approximately 3,000 years ago. The islands are home to several historical and architectural sites, including Tan Hiep Yen Sao Shrine (built in 1843 at Bai Huong) and Hai Tang Pagoda (built in 1753 on the western hillside of Hon Lao).

What appeals to tourists in Cham Island is its wide variety of leisure activities in a picturesque and pristine setting. Traditional forms of recreation range from swimming on crystal-clear

AN UNTOUCHED PARADISE

07:30 – 08:00 Pick up from your villa in Da Nang, then depart for Cua Dai Port in Hoi An to begin your journey to the Cham Islands.

On the way, stop at Non Nuoc Stone Carving Village, located at the foot of the Marble Mountains, where you can admire beautiful stone and marble artworks crafted by local artisans.

Continue to Cham Islands by high-speed canoe, enjoying an exciting ride across the waves. Along the way, take in the stunning coastal scenery before arriving at this pristine island paradise, well known for its crystal-clear waters and vibrant coral reefs.

KINGDOM OF AQUATIC ANIMALS

Around 3,000 people live on the Cham Islands, mainly around Lang Beach and Chong Beach.

At Lang Beach, you will visit several interesting sites such as Au Thuyen—a natural shelter for boats during bad weather, the ancient Hai Tang Pagoda, and Ong Temple.

After that, continue to Ong Beach / Huong Beach, where you can enjoy crystal-clear waters, relax on the sandy beach, and explore vibrant coral reefs filled with colorful fish. You will then enjoy a delicious seafood lunch before heading back to the mainland.
