Known as the tourism hub of Central Vietnam, the city also boasts stunning sunsets along its coastline, set against a backdrop of green mountains.

Da Nang is home to many fascinating attractions, including Ba Na Hills, Marble Mountains, and Linh Ung Pagoda, as well as the scenic Han River. Its beautiful beaches, such as My An Beach and Non Nuoc Beach, stretch for dozens of kilometers along the coast.

Beyond its natural beauty, Da Nang is also an ancient land closely connected to the rich heritage of the Sa Huynh culture.

Many impressive relics—palaces, towers, temples, citadels, and ramparts dating from the 1st to the 13th centuries—can be seen at the Cham Museum.

Thanks to this rich heritage, Da Nang plays an important role as a gateway for visitors, offering convenient access and excellent services. Located at the center of three UNESCO World Heritage Sites, the city is also blessed with many unforgettable natural landscapes.

09:00 – 09:30 In the morning, you will be picked up at your villa and begin the tour to the Marble Mountains, a cluster of limestone hills located within Da Nang.

Here, you can visit several religious sites, including the first Linh Ung Pagoda (Marble Mountains) and Tam Thai Pagoda, along with natural caves such as Huyen Khong Cave and Tang Chon Cave. From the viewpoints, you can admire stunning panoramic views of the mountains and the sea.

10:45 Say goodbye to the Marble Mountains and continue to the Son Tra Peninsula to visit the largest Linh Ung Pagoda (Son Tra) in Da Nang. From here, you can enjoy breathtaking views of the city, mountains, and ocean, and visit the impressive 67-meter statue of the Goddess of Mercy.

11:30 Continue to the Cham Museum, where you can learn more about Cham culture—once a thriving civilization in this region—through its rich collection of archaeological artifacts and exhibits.

12:30 Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

13:30 Visit and explore Han Market, the largest local market in Da Nang. It is well known for its fresh seafood, tropical fruits, vegetables, and a variety of local specialties—perfect for shopping and experiencing local life.

14:00 Return to your villa.
