

# HUE IMPERIAL CITY

## DAILY TOUR

Built along the Huong River, the Hue Citadel is surrounded by a 7-kilometer moat that once served both as protection and a waterway. The complex consists of three layers: the Capital Citadel, the Royal Citadel, and the Forbidden City. It was designed based on Eastern philosophy, Vietnamese traditions, and Western architectural influences. The Royal City includes more than 100 beautifully designed structures spread across different areas.

In Hue, a visit would not be complete without exploring the majestic tombs of the Nguyen emperors, located to the west of the Imperial Citadel. Nestled among hills and along the Perfume River, these royal tombs are outstanding examples of traditional Vietnamese architecture.

Less grand than the Imperial Palaces, the royal tombs offer a more peaceful and picturesque experience, surrounded by nature. One day is enough to visit the Imperial Citadel and a few royal tombs, but it is not sufficient to explore all the historical sites that reflect life here over 200 years ago.

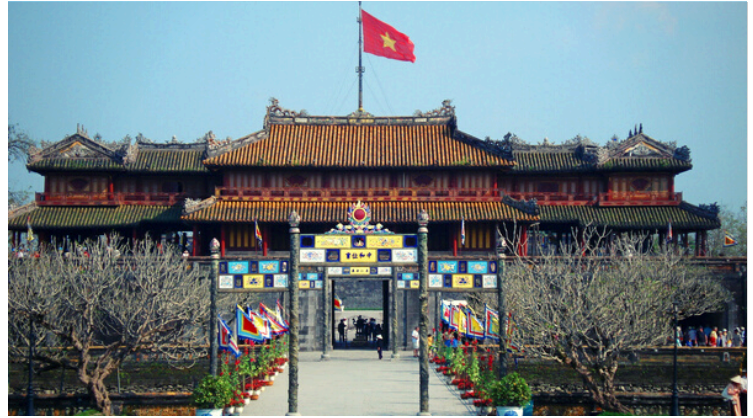
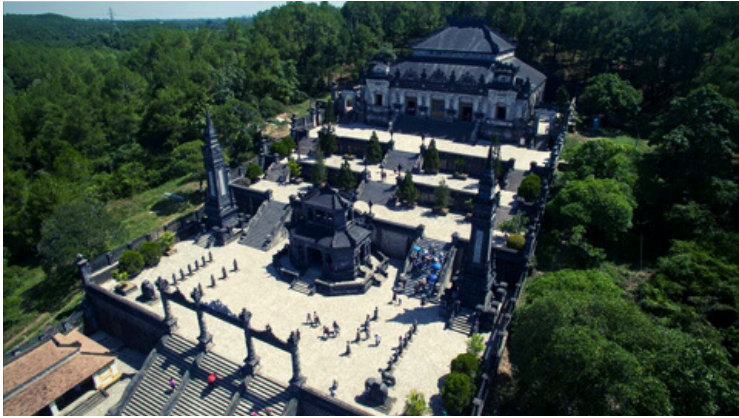

# SCHEDULE



## HUE IMPERIAL CITY - UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE

**07:30** – Pick up in Da Nang and depart for Hue City (approximately 102 km north of Da Nang).

On the way, the car will stop at some beautiful attractions:

- Hai Van Pass – a scenic mountain pass about 21 km long along National Highway 1A, forming the natural border between Da Nang and Thua Thien Hue. It is considered one of the most beautiful coastal roads in Vietnam.
- Lang Co Beach – a stunning beach with over 10 km of white sand and clear blue water, perfect for relaxing, taking photos, or enjoying the view.

**10:30** – Visit the Tomb of Khai Dinh, known for its unique blend of Eastern and Western architectural styles.

**12:00** – Enjoy lunch and take a short rest at a local restaurant.

**13:00** – Continue the tour with a visit to the Imperial City of Hue, the former palace of 13 Nguyen emperors. Highlights include Ngo Mon Gate, Thai Hoa Palace, the Royal Library, and the Nine Dynastic Urns. After that, visit Thien Mu Pagoda, one of the most iconic religious and historical sites in Hue.

**15:30** – Depart Hue and return to Da Nang. Drop-off at your villa.
