Hoi An Ancient Town is an exceptionally well-preserved example of a Southeast Asian trading port dating from the 15th to the 19th century. Its architecture and street layout reflect a unique blend of local and foreign influences, creating a truly distinctive heritage site.

The town has retained its traditional wooden houses and original urban layout, including plot sizes, building materials, façades, and rooflines. Many buildings still face the river, with historic quays, canals, and bridges remaining intact in their original setting.

The Marble Mountains are a cluster of five marble and limestone hills, named after the five elements of Eastern philosophy: metal, wood, water, fire, and earth.

These mountains feature a fascinating network of caves and tunnels, which were once used as shelters and strategic bases during wartime.

Nearby, visitors can explore Non Nuoc Stone Carving Village, famous for its traditional stone sculptures and handicrafts. Here, you can find a wide range of marble products, from small items such as earrings and necklaces to large statues, including impressive Buddha sculptures.

17:00 Say goodbye to the Marble Mountains and Non Nuoc Village, then continue to Hoi An Ancient Town. Upon arrival, enjoy a walking tour through the ancient town, visiting traditional houses, assembly halls, and ancestral temples, as well as the iconic Japanese Covered Bridge.

At night, the town becomes even more charming with colorful lanterns lighting up the streets and the lively night market offering a variety of souvenirs.
