Their sophisticated construction demonstrates the advanced engineering skills of the Cham people, while the intricate carvings and symbolic designs provide valuable insight into the development of Cham religious and political beliefs.

My Son Sanctuary is a remarkable architectural complex that developed over the course of ten centuries. It offers a vivid insight into the spiritual and political life of the Champa Kingdom during an important period in Southeast Asian history.

07:30 – 08:00 Pick-up at your meeting point in Da Nang or Hoi An, then depart for My Son Sanctuary, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

The journey from Da Nang takes approximately 1.5 hours. Upon arrival, you will explore the ancient ruins with our tour guide for about 2 hours, discovering the historical and cultural remains that reflect the glorious era of the Champa civilization.

During your visit to My Son Sanctuary, the guide will introduce you to the remains of the ancient brick towers and explain the origin and historical significance of the site, as well as the meaning behind each structure.

12:00 – Depart My Son for Hoi An by car and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.
